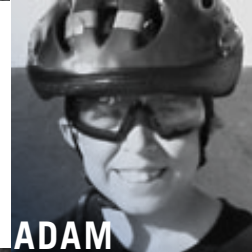

Started in 1934, the All-American Soap Box Derby has become an American tradition. It affords families an opportunity to bond with their kids as they build and race their own cars, working together to meet the challenge of gravity racing. Once again California Family Soap Box Derby Association (CFSBDA) will host the Greater Los Angeles Soap Box Derby Local Area Championship Race, the largest, sanctioned All-American Soap Box Derby (AASBD) event in greater Los Angeles. This year's race will take place June 5&6th, 2010 in Ventura CA. The race will be divided into two divisions, Stock and Super Stock and the winner in each division will represent Greater Los Angeles on July 24, 2010 in the 73rd All-American Soap Box Derby Championships in Akron, Ohio. All boys and girls from Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino, Ventura, Santa Barbara, Kern, San Luis Obispo and Riverside counties meeting the age requirements are invited to race.

Race Schedule:

Saturday, June 5th

Registration, Free practice 9:00 a.m.—1:00 p.m.
Inspection and Weigh-in 1:00—5:00 p.m.

Sunday, June 6th Race Day

Racer check-in 7:30—8:00 a.m.
Group photo 8:15 a.m.
Cars to top of hill 8:30 a.m.
Driver's meeting 9:00 a.m.
Racing starts 9:30 a.m.

Location:

On Hillmont Street, between Loma Vista Road and Foothill in Ventura CA.

Cars:

Only official car kits purchased from the All-American Soap Box Derby store at www.aasbd.org are allowed.

Wheels:

Only official Z-Glas wheels are allowed. Wheels must be retained by standard AASBD washers and wheel clips. No added lubrication after the race starts. You will be swapping wheels with your opponents and may not get your wheels back until the end of the race. If you must leave early, please notify the race director **before** you retrieve your wheels.

Divisions:

Stock, ages 8 (by race day) through 13 (must not turn 14 before 7-24-10).
Super Stock, ages 10 (by race day) through 17 (must not turn 18 before 7-24-10).

Racer Weight Limits (includes driver):

Stock, 200 lbs. total, 107.5 lbs. max tail weight. (15 lbs. tail heavy)
Super Stock, 230 lbs. total, 125 lbs. max tail weight. (20 lbs. tail heavy)

Race Format:

The race will be double elimination, lane and wheel swap, timer differential. We reserve the right to alter the race format based on weather and track conditions on the day of the race.

Rules:

All American Soap Box Derby 2010 rules will apply. It is the entrant's responsibility to read, understand and comply with all rules. Use the check list supplied in the official AASBD car construction plans to check your car prior to submitting it for inspection. Copies of the rules are packaged with the car kits. Additional copies can be downloaded from www.aasbd.org.

No tools are permitted in the pit area on race day. Race damage can be repaired or brake pads can be changed only at the designated repair stations using the tools supplied and **only after getting permission** from the race director.

Only one "handler" will be allowed in the pit area to assist each racer.

All participants must race in the T-shirts that will be supplied and wear the AASBD-issued helmet included in your kit.

All cars are required to display any race sponsor logos on their cars for this race and the two winners must display it on their cars in Akron.

Any protests against other entries must be lodged with a race official prior to the start of the race. (Exception: car is altered during the race.)

Car Inspection:

To participate in this race, racers must sign-in and all cars must receive a detailed safety and construction inspection on Saturday June 5th (the day before the race), between 1:00 and 5:00 P.M. **THERE WILL BE NO INSPECTIONS OR REGISTRATION ON THE DAY OF THE RACE!**

Car numbers and labels for each wheel, identifying car number and wheel location, will be provided at registration. These must be affixed prior to inspection. The inspections will take place in the parking lot at the foot of Hillmont Street. All set-up work on the car must be completed prior to inspection. Bring the tools you feel you may need to make final adjustments. All cars will be impounded immediately after being inspected and weighed. **Once impounded, no further work will be permitted.** Cars will be kept overnight in the parking lot watched by a security guard. You will need to provide your own car cover (a twin-size, plastic mattress cover works perfectly).

The pre-race inspection helps ensure the safety of the racers and the fairness of the race. You will be given an opportunity to make required corrections if time permits.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 6th in both Stock and Super Stock divisions. Participation awards for the balance of the field. **First place winners will be provided with race car shipping and some financial support for the trip to Akron, Ohio, to participate in the 73rd All-American Soap Box Derby on Saturday July 24, 2010!**

Entry forms are available at www.cfsbda.org. If registering more than one child submit a separate form for each entrant. **Racers that do not already have their birth certificate on file with AASBD must present a photo copy at sign-in.** Completed entry forms along with the \$50 entry, fee payable to CFSBDA, should be mailed to:
