

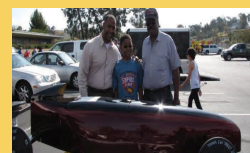

AASBD Rally Racing In The Diamond Neighborhood

Hello Racers! Join us for a San Diego All American Soap Box Derby Rally Race in beautiful San Diego Ca. on April 25 2015 in the Diamond Neighborhood.

Location: Intersection of 61st Street and Skyline Drive in the neighborhood of Encanto-San Diego Ca.

Registration Fee: \$35.00

Schedule:

7:00-8:30 AM Track set-up and Sign-in

7:30-9:00 AM Weigh-in and inspection

9:00 AM Opening Ceremonies

9:30 Drivers Meeting

9:45 AM Celebrity Race

10:00 AM Practice runs as needed for first time drivers

10:30 AM Racing Starts

Race Format: One double elimination race. Lane Swap, 4-wheel progressive swap, timer differential. We reserve the right to alter the race format based on weather and track conditions on the day of the race.



Divisions:

Stock, ages 7 to 14

Super Stock, 10 to 17

Masters, 10 to 17

Drivers must be the right age of the division their racing in on the day of the race.

Rally Champions that qualify to go to Akron must submit a copy of their birth certificate to AASBD headquarters prior to going to the championship race in July.

Rules:

All American Soap Box Derby 2014/2015 rules apply. All protests against other entries must be lodged prior to the start of the race. Exception: car is altered during the race.

Food: There will be food available for purchase at the track.

Awards: There will be trophies and participation awards given out at the end of the race.

Trophies will be given in all divisions from 1st place through 6th place.

Racing On Skyline Drive

Weigh-in and Inspection:

All cars will be weighed and inspected prior to the race for both safety and rules compliance.

Weight Limits:

Stock, 200 lbs.

Super Stock, 240 lbs.

Masters, 255 lbs.

No tail weight limit.

Wheels: Only official Z-Glass

wheels may be used. No added lubrication after the race starts. Wheels must be retained by standard AASBD washers and wheel pins. Mark your wheels and location (i.e. left front) clearly on each wheel. You will be swapping all four wheels with your opponent between phases and will not retrieve your wheels until the end of the race day. If you must leave early please notify



the Race Director.
